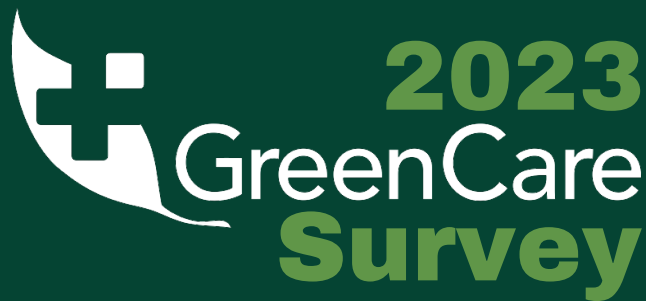

Extreme weather events impacted job duties in 2022

Snow or ice - 29% of responses
Heat waves - 14% of responses
Extreme cold - 9% of responses

Most common impacts on job duties

- Couldn't physically get to work
- Myself and/or my family members experienced impacts to our physical or mental wellbeing
- Workspace (home/out-of-home) physically impacted
- I experienced patient surges or interruption to care related to the weather events
