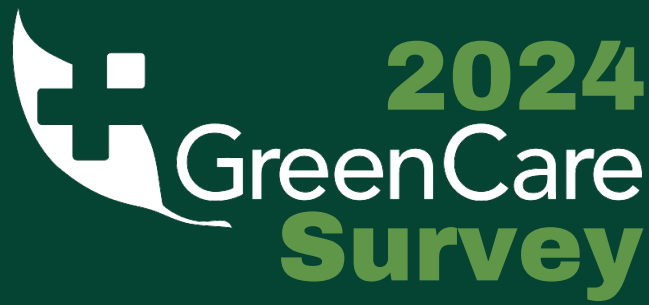

Electric Vehicles (EVs)



- 13% of staff own an EV
- 7% of commuting was done with an EV
- 29% of staff plan to own an EV in the next five years

Extreme weather events impacted job duties in 2023

- 27% of responses reported impacts from snow or ice
- 13% of responses reported impacts from heat waves
- 11% of responses reported impacts from wildfire smoke

Most common impacts on job duties

- Couldn't physically get to work
- Myself and/or my family members experienced impacts to our physical or mental wellbeing
- I experienced patient surges or interruption to care related to the weather events
